<p align="center"><u>Education and Wellness Model</u></p> <p>Activities and programs that provide education and prevention to consumers. This may be disease specific or general wellness</p>	<p align="center"><u>Coordination Model</u></p> <p>Activities that coordinate physical and behavioral healthcare for consumers. Coordinator may be independent of PH/BH organization.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Collaboration Model</u></p> <p>PH/BH organizations actively working together to coordinate care with the consumer. Co-location of Primary Care and Behavioral Health Services occur.</p>	<p align="center"><u>Integration Models</u></p> <p>An organization that provides BH or PH as core services, and also provides screening, evaluation, and treatment of the other service (PH or BH) either with own staff or agency contracted professionals. PH &amp; BH staff are members of the same team.</p>
