DISCUSSION:



The Initial Certified Investigator (CI) course was created to provide one of the many resources to achieve the goal above.

The four day face to face course was created to ensure all incidents that require an investigation, receive a systematic investigation that meets established standards. In order to perform investigations, the investigator must successfully complete all requirements under the ODP CI Training.


Current course offerings are available on myODP.org. Users can register for the course using their current myODP credentials and using the following path: Training > Certified Investigator Program > Initial Certification Instructions.

To register for a course:

1. Click on the link above the class schedule (red arrow)



2. On the Training Registration Page, click on the "Book Now" button for the session you want to attend (green arrow).



3. If the session you would like to attend is full, you can join the waiting list by clicking the Waiting List link at the top of the page or within each session's information, (Users can be put on the waiting for up to four sessions).
