ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) is a set of proactive, options-based strategies that increase your chances of survival during a violent intruder or Active Shooter event. For 14 years, the ALICE Training Institute has provided violent intruder response training to individuals and organizations across the nation.

This 2-Day Instructor training course is designed to teach law enforcement as well as school, church, hospital and workplace administrators and employee's skills and strategies that bridge the gap between the time a violent event begins and law enforcement arrives.

- **Background:** You will become knowledgeable in statistics and information about active shooter situations and why ALICE training is effective.
- **ALICE Concepts:** We will deliver a detailed overview of ALICE training and the liability of proactive vs. passive response strategies.
- **Physical Drills:** You will experience live scenario drills that compare passive vs. active responses.
- **Effective Training:** You will learn the strategies and be provided with materials to become an effective ALICE Instructor in your own organization.

This training will create ALICE Certified Instructors (ACI) who will serve as the Violent Intruder Response subject-matter domain person(s) for the organization. ACI's will conduct all hands-on training (demonstrations, practical scenarios, and evaluation drills) that complement and enhance the response options, strategies, and concepts learned in the ALICE e-Learning.

Demonstrations provide visual examples of strategic techniques and physical recommendations, and show how they achieve the desired objective and benefit.

Practical scenarios allow the learners to practice both decision-making and physical exercises, building muscle memory and making quicker, proper response choices probable. This is very important component for increasing survival.

Evaluation drills are announced events that make building occupants respond to provided stimulus. Their choices and responses are observed by the ACI's in order to evaluate the learning conducted through the e-Learning, demonstrations, and practical scenarios.

ACI's will also have access to ATI-provided templates and recommendations that will assist in the enterprise roll-out of the new plan, policy, and procedures. ACI's will assist Executive Level, HR, Security, and other related staff in establishing guidelines, timelines, documentation, presentations, and all other requirements need for ALICE Implementation.
