PURPOSE: To communicate to the above entities that Temple University's Institute on Protective Services will be facilitating a Forum for Certified Investigators (CIs).

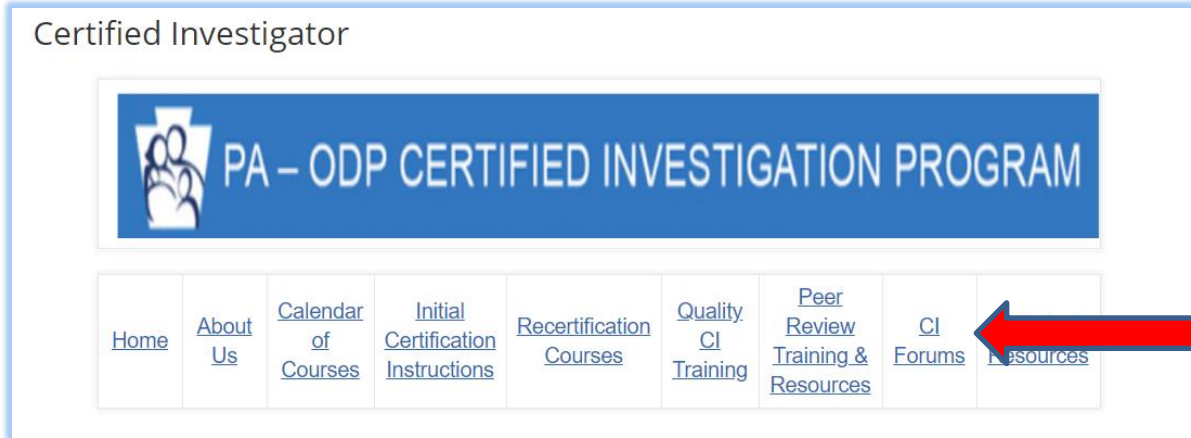
DISCUSSION:

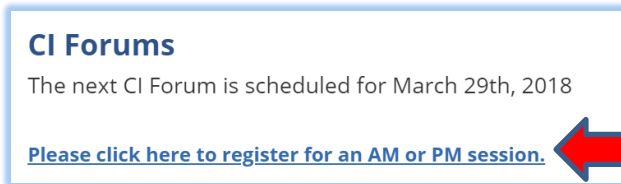

How to register for the CI Forum:

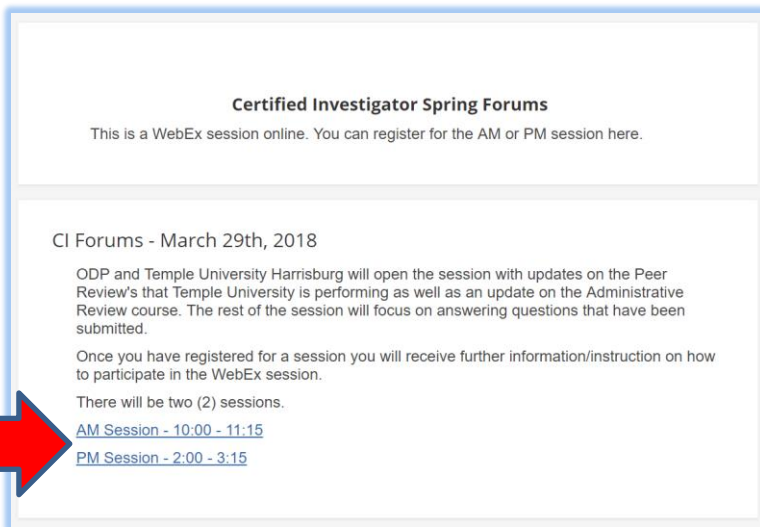
1. Navigate to: www.myodp.org
