	Misapplication/unauthorized use of a restraint	<b>Same</b> with secondary natures split into injury and no injury
	Sexual	<b>Reported under Primary Nature of Sexual Abuse</b>
<b>Neglect</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Neglect* (Same)</b>
<b>Psychiatric Hospitalization</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Behavioral Health Crisis Event*</b>
<b>Hospitalization</b>	All Illness or injury secondary natures	<b>Serious Illness*</b>
		<b>Serious Injury*</b>
<b>ER visit</b>	All injury secondary natures	<b>Serious Injury*</b>
<b>Injury Requiring Treatment Beyond First Aid</b>	All injury secondary natures	<b>Serious Injury*</b>
<b>Misuse of Funds</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Exploitation*</b>
<b>Missing Person</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Missing Individual*</b>
<b>Restraint</b>	Physical	<b>Physical Restraint (Same)</b>
	Mechanical	<b>Abuse</b>
	Chemical	<b>Abuse</b>
<b>Med Error</b>	Wrong person <i>or</i> med error occurred over more than one consecutive administration	<b>Neglect* and Medication Error (requires two reports to be linked)</b>
	All other secondary natures	<b>Medication Error (Same)</b>
<b>Individual to Individual Abuse</b>	Physical	<b>Individual to Individual Abuse (Same)</b>
	sexual	<b>Sexual Abuse* as a primary category</b>
	verbal	<b>Individual to Individual Abuse (Same) (verbal now considered psychological)</b>
	psychological	<b>Abuse (Same)</b>
<b>Rights Violation</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Rights Violation* (Same)</b>
<b>Death</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Death (Same)</b>
<b>Fire</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Fire* (Same) but excludes the need to report False Alarms</b>
<b>Law Enforcement Activity</b>	All secondary natures	<b>Law Enforcement Activity* (Same) only when an individual is charged with a crime or a site crime occurs. Note that moving violations are now a secondary category under Neglect.</b>
